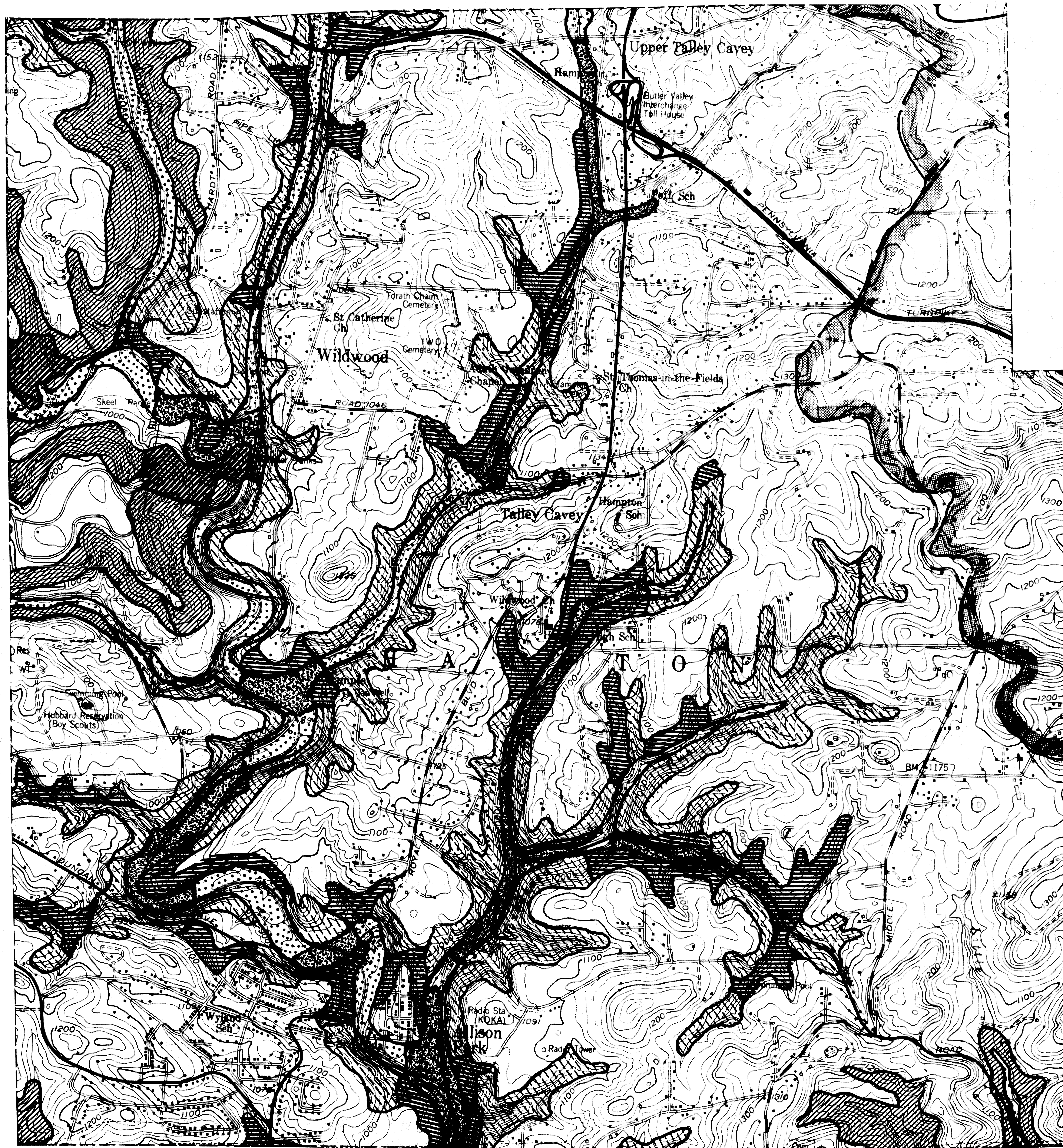




LEGEND

FLOOD PLAINS - Area I

Level lands along streams, valuable water resources; wet alluvium soil.

- OPEN UNDEVELOPED - 1A Idle, park, woodlands, farms, golf courses and sportsman's clubs.
- URBAN DEVELOPED - 1B Industrial, commercial, residential, municipal.

STEEP SLOPES - EARTH FLOW PRONE - Area II

Wooded steep slopes prone to earthflow landslides if vegetation is removed. Clay and shale layers, "Pittsburgh Redbeds", fairly drained.

- OPEN UNDEVELOPED - 1 Idle, park, woodlands, farms, golf courses and sportsman's clubs.
- URBAN DEVELOPED Industrial, commercial, residential, municipal.

STEEP SLOPES - ROCKFALL PRONE - Area III

Wooded steep slopes prone to rockfall landslides if vegetation is removed. Shale and sand layers, well drained.

- OPEN UNDEVELOPED Idle, park, woodlands, farms, golf courses and sportsman's clubs.
- URBAN DEVELOPED Industrial, commercial, residential, municipal.

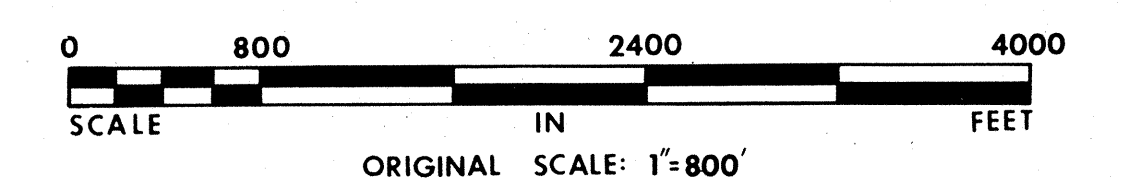
Note: Steep slopes are greater than 25 %
