-  **BATTERIES PLUS:** 4808 McKnight Road location. 412-366-3600. Accepts all kinds of batteries. There is a fee for CFL and fluorescent bulbs.
-  **CENTRAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL:** Located on Middle Road. A box located in the lobby area for printer cartridges.
-  **JT TIRE:** 412-486-3997. Accepts used tires for a fee.
-  **APPLIANCE WAREHOUSE:** 1-800-GO-FREON. Allegheny County residents can recycle appliances that are Freon-based such as refrigerators and water heaters. Items can be dropped off at the Lawrenceville location at 73 McCandless Avenue free of charge. You can also schedule a pick- up at your home for a fee.
-  **LOCAL LIBRARIES:** Hampton Library 412-684-1098 and Shaler North Hills Library 412-486-0211 accept used books in good condition, and DVD's. Please call first before dropping items off.
