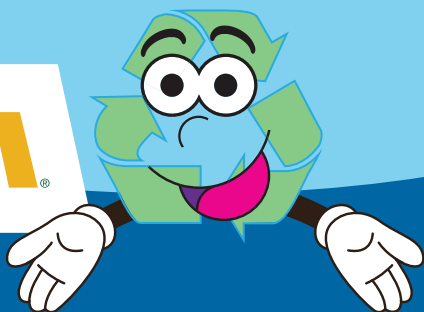

At Your Door HHW and E-Waste

Customer Handbook

For 2026, Hampton Township and Waste Management continue to provide you with our automated trash, recycling, yard waste, household hazardous waste and e-waste collection program. This handbook summarizes the way the service is organized and how you can make best use of it.

Your collection day will remain the same. All items must be placed at the curb no later than 6 a.m. on the day of your collection. Despite our best efforts, we occasionally miss scheduled collections. If we do, please call us at (800) 451-3060 or 412-486-0400 x1303 as soon as you can. Your representatives will work with you to ensure your materials get picked up. You can also visit www.wm.com for live chat and email options.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Billing

Waste Management will bill each household on a four-month basis according to the level of service selected. Payment has to be applied by the due date. Customer prices are set from year-to-year based on the contract. Recycling, yard waste collection service, as well as HHW and e-waste collection are offered at no additional cost. Upon request, senior citizens age 65 or over shall qualify for a 10% discount upon submittal to Waste Management of proof of age in the form of a valid driver's license or other recognized photo ID and documentation of financial responsibility for the household.

Regular Curbside Rates

Customer rates for the 2026 calendar year with Waste Management are as follows:

- \$158.04 every 4 months for regular service
- \$142.24 for senior rate every 4 months (10% discount)
- \$450.41 for residents paying for entire year before Feb 28th (5% discount)
- \$405.38 for senior rate paying for entire year

Collection Times

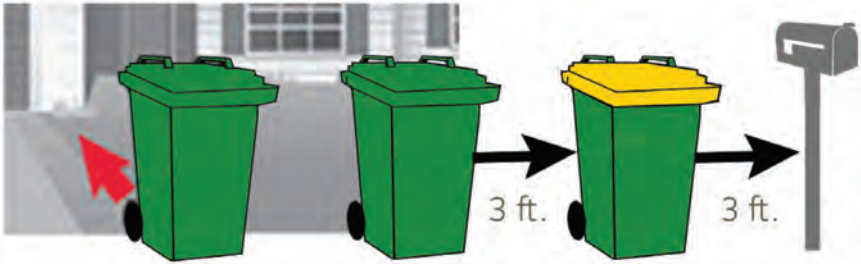
Carts should be placed at the curb no earlier than 5:00 p.m. the night before your scheduled collection day. Collections will occur between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, unless delayed for holiday pickup. If your cart is not out by the time the truck arrives at your household, you will have to wait until the following week for service. Retrieve your carts no later than 24 hours after pickup.

DO I HAVE TO PARTICIPATE IN COLLECTION?

Under Pennsylvania's Act 101 of 1989, the Allegheny County Solid Waste Plan and by community ordinance, residents of Hampton Township are required to utilize the residential collection service provided by their respective municipality. These laws also require that should the collector find that a customer is contaminating recyclables by mixing items that cannot be recycled together with items that can, Waste Management will not collect them. Likewise, if the collector finds that wastes are improperly contained, overweight, or placed out of reach, the company can decline to collect them. Other waste-related violations, including illegal dumping, will be addressed by either the state or the township, depending on the circumstances.

PROPER CART PLACEMENT

Place your cart at least 3 feet away from all objects including your second cart, mailbox, car, or tree. The lid opening should face the street with the wheels of the cart facing your house.



Place wheels of cart toward house

Keep space between carts and other objects.



Do not obstruct collection of carts or bulk items by parking vehicles in the vicinity. Keep area clear for easy access by collection truck.



All trash must be bagged and fit inside the cart with the lid firmly closed. Material outside of the cart will not be collected.



Please have your trash cart at the curb the night before your regular collection day or by 6 a.m. on your pickup day.

NEED AN ADDITIONAL CART?

Each 96-gallon cart will hold approximately eight (8) standard size kitchen trash bags. If needed, additional trash carts are available for a one time fee of \$100 per cart. Residents can request up to two additional carts.

YARD WASTE

Yard Waste will be collected by Waste Management the 3rd full week of each month from April through November, the same day as your trash and recycling. **See the calendar at the end of this booklet for your 2026 yard waste collection weeks.**

The Township recognizes that for most property owners, storing leaf bags for once a month collection can be very difficult. This being the case, Township Community Services/Road Crews will collect leaf bags only (in paper biodegradable bags) **from Oct. 26th thru Dec. 4th**. This collection will take place on the off weeks that Waste Management does not collect yard waste. Place the leaf bags at the curb by 6 am the morning of your normal waste/recycling day; our crews will be by to collect them as soon as possible. Please visit the Township's website at www.hampton-pa.org or "Township of Hampton" Facebook page in the fall of each year for possible date changes (this date may change due to winter weather conditions).

ACCEPTED

- Leaves in paper biodegradable bags
- Branches, tree limbs under 4" diameter and up to 4' in length
- Brush
- Plants, flowers, roots, and shrubbery with soil shaken off
- Prunings

NOT ACCEPTED

- Soil, mulch and sod
- Kitchen food waste
- Garden or orchard food waste
- Excrement, pet droppings, kitty litter
- Plastics or synthetics
- Tree stumps & limbs over 4" thick or 4' long
- Non-compostable bags or boxes
- Lumber or construction material
- Christmas trees in plastic bags

Grass clippings will NOT be collected as part of yard waste. Grass clippings may be put in plastic bags and placed in your regular trash can on garbage day.

Christmas trees will be collected in the months of December, January and February. Trees must be cut into lengths no greater than six feet. Set next to your trash cart on your regular collection day. These are not considered a bulk item.

BULK ITEMS, APPLIANCES AND VOLUME PICKUPS

Bulk Items and Overflow Material

Waste Management will only collect material that fits inside your trash and recycling cart. All trash must be bagged and fit inside the provided cart. Recyclables must be placed loose into your recycling cart and boxes must be broken down.

Residents may purchase up to two (2) additional 96-gallon trash carts for a one time fee of \$100 per cart. Residents may also purchase up to two (2) additional 64-gallon recycling carts for \$85 per cart.

Waste Management will collect one bulk item once per month during the 4th full week of the month at no additional charge. Place your bulk item at the curb on the same day as your trash collection during your bulk collection week. Additional items can be arranged for pickup for a fee by calling WM.

See the calendar at the end of this booklet for your 2026 bulk collection weeks.

What is a Bulk Item:

A bulk item is an appliance, piece of furniture, or some other residential item that is too large for a container. Construction debris and hazardous waste are not permitted as bulk items. WM asks that residents call 1-800-451-3060 in advance to schedule collection of any white-good appliances.

SPECIAL NOTE ON FREON APPLIANCE DISPOSAL

When a refrigerator, freezer, air conditioner, or dehumidifier is disposed of, a licensed technician must remove the Freon® or other refrigerant for recycling before sending the item away. You can contact your own heating/air conditioning professional, or call Appliance Warehouse at 412-381-8800 for help. State law also requires the removal of refrigerator and freezer doors to avoid the entrapment of children. If replacing an old appliance, you may want to ask the store upon delivery of your new appliance if they provide removal of your old unit at the same time.

NOT Bulk Waste and Unaccepted Materials

- **CARDBOARD BOXES AND GARBAGE BAGS FULL OF REFUSE SET OUTSIDE OF THE TRASH CART.**
- Concrete, brick, asphalt, roofing, electronics
- Vehicles, vehicle parts and tires
- Building materials such as plaster, dry wall, wood, construction debris, etc.

Residents do not have to call Waste Mgt. for the one bulk item per month.

Listed below are examples of bulk items and the cost per item after the first free one per month. Residents must call WM at 1-800-451-3060 to pay for two or more bulk items per month.

Bulk Item	Cost Per Item
Large Appliances (washers, dryers, stoves, dishwashers)	\$42.00
Small Appliances (trash compactors)	\$27.00
Large C&D* (Materials must be cut down into pieces no more than 4 ft. in length and bundled, each weighing no more than 40 pounds. Any nails must be removed or pounded into material)	\$75.00
Small C&D* (cabinetry, vanity, interior door or closet door, light fixture, metal or exterior door, dry paint cans)	\$42.00
Carpet - Cut in sections no longer than 48 inches, securely rolled and tied, 6 bundled sections.	\$33.50
Large Furniture (table, sofa, chest, dresser, door, armoire, etc.)	\$47.00
Small Furniture (headboard, chair, lamps, vacuum cleaners, larger toys, bed rail, street bicycle, card table, step ladder, etc.)	\$27.00
Mattress/Box Spring	\$27.00
Large Outdoor Furniture and Items (picnic table and benches, snowblower, assembled basketball hoop and pole, disassembled swing set, lawn furniture, etc.)	\$150.00
Small Outdoor Furniture and Items (ladder, push lawnmower, basketball board or pole under space 4ft., garage door opener assembly, exterior door, car top carrier, child's swimming pool, screen door, etc.)	\$42.00
Porcelain Fixtures	\$33.50
Refrigerator and Freezer (Freon must be removed, see page 8)	\$150.00
Sport and Exercise Equipment	\$27.00

* "C&D" - Construction and Demolition (contact Waste Management for further clarification of materials accepted under Large C&D).

VOLUME PICKUP:

Collection of large quantities of bagged excess waste from cleanouts of attics, basements and garages, provided the waste meets the definition of acceptable waste. Volume pickups are based on a unit charge that includes the collection and disposal.

Multiple appliances and/or bulk items will be billed at their individual rate and will not be included in a volume pick up rate.

AT YOUR DOOR HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW) AND E-WASTE COLLECTION

As a part of the contract with Waste Management, residents have a convenient opportunity to dispose of Household Hazardous Waste — such as cleaners, chemicals and automotive products — and E-Waste — such as old computers, televisions and other electronics.

The At Your Door HHW and E-Waste Collection Program allows residents to easily dispose of these often difficult-to-recycle items at no cost.

How to participate...

First, you have to schedule your collection. There are three ways to do this:

The call center operators will guide you through the steps toward a safe and successful collection. You will be asked several questions, including your address and the type and amount of materials available for the pick up. You will be provided a convenient collection date and information about where to place the kit for collection. A kit will be sent to your home in plenty of time for you to gather and pack your materials.



Preparing for collection

The collection kit includes an instruction sheet and other items to help pack and secure your household generated special materials. Please read the instruction sheet included in the kit.

On the day of collection

On the scheduled date, the customer service technician will collect materials directly from your home. They will sort and pack the materials for proper transportation, recycling and disposal. Participants will receive a postage-paid survey card to complete and mail back to help track the program.

Got more stuff than will fit in the kit? Don't worry.

Remember, this service is available year-round, and the cost is included in your regular trash bill. Just schedule another collection! Small quantities may be combined with your neighbors. ACCEPTABLE

Must be placed INSIDE the kit

- Vehicle batteries** (up to 4)
- Fluorescent tubes and CFLs** (up to 10, placed inside their original sheaths or taped together)
- Televisions** (one at a time)
- Microwave ovens**
- One computer system** (one each of the following: CPU/tower, monitor, keyboard, mouse, desktop printer)
- Electronics with circuit boards** (CD Rom, VCRs, cell phones, DVD/CD/tape players, related cords) — up to 25 pounds

UNACCEPTABLE

- Items that are improperly packaged for transport
- Biological waste
- Construction materials
- Smoke detectors
- Unknown materials
- Pressurized cylinders
- Ammunition
- Leaking containers
- Items in containers over 5 gallons
- Commercial products
- E-cigarettes
- All medicines
- Empty containers
- Asbestos
- Tires
- Radioactive materials
- Fire extinguishers
- Explosives
- Unlabeled containers
- Business supplies from homes
- Trash, including bulky items

Waste Management will NOT collect any materials in unlabeled or leaking containers. If you have questions about proper disposal methods for non-acceptable items, commercial chemicals or hazardous materials in containers larger than five gallons in size, please contact the call center at 1-800-449-7587.
